The past perfect (die Vorvergangenheit)

The people at the meeting decided to protest because the police had arrested Rosa.

- 1 first event (that happened first)
- 2 second event (that happened then)

Bildung

1. first event → past perfect  
had + Verb in 3. Form /-ed Endung

2. second event → simple past  
Verb in 2. Form /-ed Endung

First ths had happened (past perfect)	Then this happened (simple past)
The seats at the back of the bus <b>had filled</b> up,	so Rosa <b>sat</b> in the middle of the bus.
Because Rosa <b>hadn't moved</b> ,	the driver <b>stopped</b> the bus and <b>called</b> the police
After the police <b>had arrested</b> Rosa,	there <b>was</b> a big meeting in Montgomery.
Before the boycott, people <b>had taken</b> the bus to work every day.	But now they <b>stopped</b> using the buses.
After the black people of Montgomery <b>had protested</b> for 381 days,	the law in Alabama <b>was</b> changed and segregation on buses <b>became</b> illegal.

past perfect	simple past
dad hadn't called me	I got up late
my brother had finished the mild	I didn't have breakfast
I had left my bag at home	(At school) I discovered
I had done my homework	I told the English teacher
I had often forgotten my homework before	she didn't believe me
I had put my sandwiches in my bag	I didn't have any lunch
she had found my bag in the dog's bed	(Later at home) mum told me
someone had eaten them	there were no sandwiches in the bag.
